Timetable B

9.15 am	Arrive, registration and coffee
9.45 am	Worship "Who Is the Holy Spirit and What Does He Do?"
10.45 am	Coffee and small groups
11.30 am	"How Can I Be Filled with the Holy Spirit?"
1.15 pm	Lunch and free time/ group time (Activities e.g. game of football/walk etc.)
3.30 pm	Tea
4.00 pm	Worship "How Can I Make the Most of the Rest of My Life?"
5.00 pm	Finish
