Tricia has led the growth of Alpha since she joined the staff in 1994 from News International. She has overseen the growth of Alpha courses from 200 in 1994 to more than 41,000 in 163 countries world-wide and set up 44 National Alpha Offices. More than 13 million people have done the Alpha course since she joined the staff. Since Tricia became involved in the running of HTB Church it has grown from 3 Sunday services to 7 – and has planted several churches.

Rebecca Stewart is the National Director of Alpha UK and has been on the staff at HTB/Alpha for 6 years, prior to which she worked in the City in banking, consulting and head-hunting.
